MB PhD (and BDS PhD) OPPORTUNITY 2023

In 2023, we expect to have up to 7 funded PhD positions available for highly motivated University of Edinburgh or University of Glasgow MBChB students on completion of their intercalated BMedSci.

The CRUK TRACC and Kennedy Trust TRAM MB PhD programmes have been designed to help develop the future leaders in biomedical research by providing an early route to an academic career for highly promising students. Successful candidates will be closely mentored by senior academic staff, will be placed into top research laboratories of their choice (in Edinburgh or Glasgow and across both Universities) and will complete a 3-year PhD before returning to the fourth year of their MBChB course. A full stipend will be provided.

Who is eligible to apply? (i) MBChB students from either University currently in their intercalated BMedSci year (2022-2023); (ii) postgraduate students currently in 2nd year (Edinburgh) or 3rd year (Glasgow) who previously graduated with a BSc; and (iii) Glasgow BDS students currently in their intercalated BMedSci year or who previously graduated with a BSc

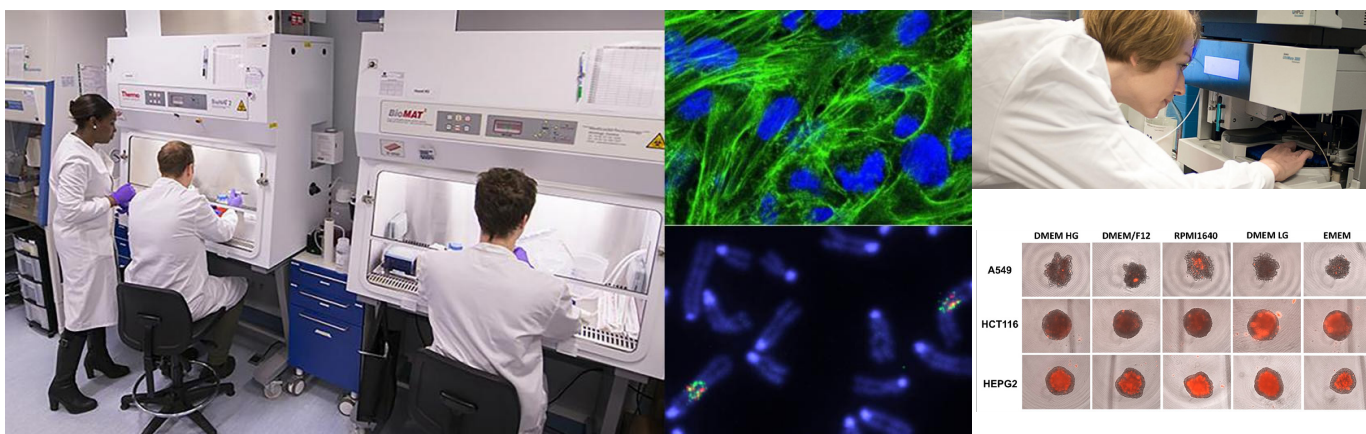
